- 3. All crew members should wear ear protection devices.
- 4. No one should cross in front of the muzzle at any time during the cleaning, loading or firing procedure.
- 5. The ammunition box shall be attended at all times, or be locked. The interior shall be lined with a non-sparking material and the box itself shall be stoutly constructed of wood or metal.
- 6. No smoking at any time on the line.
- 7. No drinking alcoholic beverages on the line.
- 8. Projectiles shall be constructed so that they easily pass through a sizing gauge with finger or thumb pressure only. The sizing gauge to be a length at least 1.5 times the length of the projectile and an inside diameter no greater than bore diameter when the tube was new.

9. It is necessary to swab the bore with a wet mop between shots. ALWAYS ALLOW 15 MINUTES TO ELAPSE BETWEEN FIRING AND RELOADING THE NEXT POWDER CHARGE.
